Collaboration with key stakeholders is key, ensuring a comprehensive, high-performance approach in the world of Bobsleigh and Skeleton. Join us in this role, where your leadership will play a key role in the evolution of this sport.



Key Responsibilities:

Leadership and Management:

- Collaborate with Coaches and Administrative staff to oversee all technical operational activities, planning, and budgets for Bobsleigh and Skeleton.
- Build and maintain an environment where everyone can thrive by promoting physical, psychological, emotional and social wellbeing through adherence of safe sport principles.
- Oversee hiring, onboarding, training, and ongoing performance conversations for coaches and technical administration staff
- Ensure compliance with Sport Canada reporting and accountability requirements.

Building and Optimizing Partnerships:

- Comprehensive communication and collaboration with National Team athletes.
- Manage and build relationships to enhance athlete performance and BCS's impact.
- Delivers effective presentations with clarity and impact at critical opportunities including: AGMs, Board Meetings, Bobsleigh & Skeleton Athlete Meetings and OTP Annual Reviews.
- Represent the sport and collaborate with key stakeholders, including Own the Podium, Sport Canada, the Canadian Olympic Committee, the Canadian Olympic and Paralympic Sport Institute Network, the International Bobsleigh & Skeleton Federation, the Coaching Association of Canada, and others.

- Evaluate and evolve Bobsleigh and Skelton National team programs through the development and monitoring of defined key performance indicators.

- Designs and implements an integrated performance science services plan through partnerships and communication with the National Team Head Coach – Bobsleigh and the National Team Head Coach – Skeleton and with purposeful feedback from National Team athletes.
